Students will be accessing the live remote lessons based in an IT room on site, students will be in mixed bubbles. Please ensure your child has a set of headphones if possible.

When your child arrives into school, please ask them to head straight to the main hall by the main student entrance/PE area. Staff will be around to guide Year 7 students who may not know where this area of the school is.

Students will follow the usual school timings of the day and be expected to wear full uniform. Food will be available at break and lunch but a smaller choice due to students numbers.

Please ensure your child brings with them a set of headphones, a water bottle and has a spare face covering.
