### Understanding assessment our remote learning reports

Staff have commented on pupils' attendance and engagement to learning during the Spring term that ran from January to the beginning of March. The definition for each attribute is outlined below

Remote Learning Engagement	
Outstanding	All work is completed to a high standard and the best of his/her ability, reflecting sustained effort and consistent engagement with learning activities. It is clear to see the enthusiasm, determination and resilience that has been applied to all tasks. Communicates effectively with the teacher. Is making rapid progress.
Good	Work is completed to a good standard, demonstrating a strong work ethic and a good level of engagement with learning activities. A conscientious attitude that supports good behaviour to learning. Requests feedback and help when necessary. Is making expected progress.
Requires Improvement	Has responded adequately to the change to remote learning but can at times appear disengaged or distracted. Not all work has been submitted and virtual tasks may not always be completed to the required standard. Does not actively seek support from the teacher if required. Minimal progress is being made.

Inadequate	Work is not completed to an acceptable standard if at all, reflecting a poor work ethic and a low level of engagement with learning activities. Withdrawn and resistant to engagement, critical of themselves or others when participating in group/class discussion., refusal/ resistant to respond to feedback, easily distracted and possibly challenging behaviour. Is making little or no progress.
Working on paper	Work has been undertaken at home on paper for a significant part of lockdown.

### Attendance

Outstanding	Attended all/almost all of their live online lessons.
Good	Attended most of their live online lessons.
Requires Improvement	Attended several live online lessons but should attend more.
Inadequate	Has not engaged fully in live online lessons, missed numerous lessons and should attend more.
Working on paper	Work has been undertaken at home on paper
