Appeals Guide

I think the grade I have been given is wrong • If you think a grade is incorrect when you receive your results, speak to the school in the first instance and request a centre review – an internal review by your school or college - so they can check for any errors.

I am still unhappy with my grade

• If you still think your grade is incorrect after your school has checked it, you can ask them to appeal to the exam board. You should be aware that on appeal, grades could go up, down, or stay the same and the exam board's decision will be final. This can also affect the grades of others on your course.

What might happen?

•Once the review is complete, the exam board will decide on a final grade for you. If the final grade is lower than the original teacher assessed grade, it will go down. If the result is higher, it will go up. Once the final grade has been issued after the review, it will be final.

When do I need to submit my request?.

You should submit a **request for a centre review before 16th August 2021 for a priority appeal.** This is for those who urgently need a review of grades in order to attain a place on their 1st choice university course. Any other appeals should be received by 3rd September 2021.
