

# **RIVERS SIXTH FORM**

## **FIRST DAY IN YEAR 12**

### **DATE AND TIME:**

- The new school term begins on **Thursday 2nd September 2021**

### **WHERE TO ASSEMBLE:**

- If you arrive early please go to the Sixth Form Area to find your SF mentor group and head to that room
- A large proportion of the morning will be an extended mentor period, which will focus on meeting your mentor, life in the Sixth Form and general administration, including receiving your timetables.

### **DRESS CODE:**

In the Sixth Form you are given the flexibility to wear your own clothes. Standards of dress and appearance should be appropriate for the business of studying and should not include styles which are extreme. Low cut tops and clothes that expose underwear should not be worn. Skirts and shorts should be of a respectable length. Tattoos should not be visible. If you fail to meet these standards, you will be placed in the Inclusion room for the day. Dress for more formal occasions (Awards Day, Open Evening, etc.) must be appropriate. .

As we operate a managed wifi solution on site, we have in place structured capacity to allow external devices internet connectivity. Users wishing to connect their device to the network should seek advice from ICT Support or the Sixth Form Team. Please be aware that wireless access is granted to Sixth Form students only on their laptop, tablet, mobile and smartphones devices. This enables students to print from multiple devices.
