Income Support or Employment Support or Jobseekers Allowance:

- Photo-copy of a recent letter from the Benefits office, or
- Photo-copy of current free school meals entitlement letter.

Working/Child Tax Credit:

Send a photo-copy of the award letter from HMRC, showing both the award and your family income, which must be NOT MORE THAN £18,000 year in total (see over).

MUSIC TUITION VOUCHER SCHEME

April 2016-April 2017

To qualify for a voucher you must be receiving one of the following or similar benefits:

- Income Support or Income Based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Working/Child Tax Credit if you:
 - receive more than the basic £545.34 per year excluding any childcare element; and
 - HMRC have assessed your annual income at £18,000 or less.
 - Applicants who receive other benefits, e.g. State or Widow's Pension or disability benefit, should also receive Child Tax Credit if they are responsible for caring for a child or children.
 - Vouchers are now issued yearly, but are valid at the rate of £46.50 per term, from April (start of Summer Term through Autumn Term) to April (end of Spring Term) for the child named on the voucher.
 - The values cannot be added together, or carried forward or back dated or used in any other combination.
 - If you do not apply in good time, you may have to pay the full amount for the term's lessons, and you may not get a voucher until the next term.
 - Vouchers will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis while we still have money left in the budget.
