KEY POINTS FOR STUDENTS – KS4

Please be certain you are clear on Exams Regulations set by the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ). Below are the key points - for full Exams Policies please refer to the ORA website

- You must be <u>ON TIME</u> for all exams, If you arrive late you may not be permitted to sit your exam. Morning exams start at **9:00 am** Go to your Tutor room and you will be accompanied to the gym. Afternoon exams start at **1:00 pm** Go to the main hall.
- You <u>MUST NOT</u> take into the exam room any device with digital storage and/or electronic connectivity. This includes a mobile phone, headphones, an MP3/4 Player or similar device.
- You <u>CANNOT</u> take watches of any kind into the exam room.
- You MUST follow the instructions of the invigilation staff at all times.
- DO NOT start your exam until you are instructed to do so.
- Pencil cases MUST be see-through.
- Water bottles MUST be see-through and any labels removed.
- You MUST write in black ink.
- You MUST NOT write inappropriate, obscene or offensive material.
- DO NOT try to communicate with or disturb other candidates once in the exam room.
- If you leave the exam room unaccompanied before the end of the exam for any reason, this will lead to a malpractice report to the Exam Board. Under these circumstances you <u>WILL NOT</u> be allowed to return to the exam room.
- Toilet breaks will only be permitted at the discretion of the lead invigilator/exams staff. Female Hygiene products will be available.
