

Parent Briefing

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we reach the end of a busy Spring term, it is important that students take some time over the holiday to rest, recuperate and enjoy time with their friends and family.

As you know, we are working hard to improve both attendance to school and lessons and punctuality and to assist with this I am please to inform you that the student punctuality module on Go4Schools is now up and running. Your child's timetable will now display lesson by lesson attendance including late, absent and illness marks displayed daily on a 24 hour delayed basis as well as showing individual subject attendance, a weekly breakdown and average daily trends for your child's attendance. Below are instructions on how to access this information. This will be available from the start of the summer term. **Please help us to support our students to arrive to school and lessons on time.**

As we move into the Summer term, please can I remind you of our uniform expectations, in particular the type of shoes your child is wearing to school:

- Black school shoes: Shoes must be plain black leather with no white or coloured logos or stitching. We do not allow suede shoes, boots, slingbacks, wedges or trainers like 'Nike Air Max'. However, we do allow all black Nike Air Force 1s, Converse, All Stars, Puma and similar but again, **they must be all black leather**.
- Academy Blazer with blue trim and Ormiston Rivers Academy Badge this must be worn to and from lessons.
- Plain black school trousers or Academy tartan mock kilt **skirt length should be at or below mid thigh.**
- Black socks or black or neutral plain tights
- White school shirt that can be done up to the top button (long or short sleeves)
- School tie to be worn at all times.
- Students are allowed to wear coats outside and when moving around the corridors, however **hoodies and non-school jumpers are not permitted**.
- Leggings are not permitted at all, whether worn as trousers or under the academy kilt, neither are jeans or chinos.

Please can we ask that parents and carers continue to support our students to remember the 3 Rs of the academy's Code:

Be Ready to learn – Arrive on time to lesson, sit in allocated seat, get out equipment and straight away start the Do Now Task. Make a positive attempt at all tasks provided.

Be Respectful – Listen in silence to teacher talk and student contributions. At the end of the lesson tidy your work area.

Be Responsible – Follow all teacher instructions. Use the support available, waiting quietly with your hand up if you need teacher help. For exit, stand behind your chair and wait to be dismissed.

I wish you all an enjoyable and restful Easter holiday and look forward to seeing our students again on Monday 15th April on their return for the Summer term.


