Go4Schools Behaviour & Detention Communication

Dear Parent/Carer,

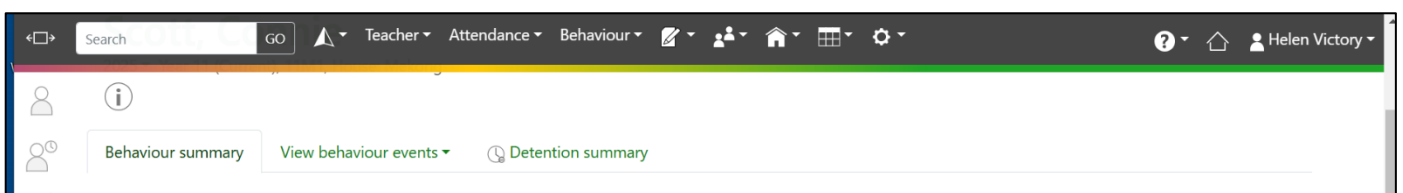
Go4Schools is used to record both positive and negative behaviour of our students and is also used to manage our detention system.

Following feedback from parents, staff and students we have reviewed our use of Go4Schools and have made some small changes to support communication. We are enabling the notifications function within Go4Schools to ensure that parents receive clear, timely communication about detentions and behaviour logs.

Teachers will no longer be phoning to inform parents that a student has been relocated and instead parents will be able to see all behaviour details via the Go4Schools system and notifications sent. Staff will contact parents if a pattern of behaviour emerges that needs discussion and interventions put in place to support that student. The detention system will now be managed by a central administrator who will ensure consistent management.

Also, please note that if you wish to view information on detentions you will need to access Go4Schools via the website not on the app. On the website if you go to behaviour you will then be able to click on Detention summary, as shown below, and this will allow you to see details of the reason, date, time and location of any upcoming detentions.
