

Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to remind parents and carers that the following information on your child is available on www.Go4schools.com, or by downloading the app.

- Assessment grades
- Attendance
- Timetables
- Behaviour
- Homework

There is more information available on the website version, showing where overall assessment grades have come from (topic tests, assessed essays etc). This can be particularly useful to see where students' strengths and weaknesses lie within each course.

As teachers conduct assessments the attainment will change accordingly over the remainder of the academic year, so please use Go4schools regularly to keep up to date with the latest attainment and timetable changes. If a subject is missing a grade, it will be due to the assessment not having taken place yet. Predictions are what staff believe a student is likely to achieve at the end of their course (Y11 GCSE grade or Y13 A level grade). These are not guarantees as grade boundaries move annually and attendance and effort within students can also change. We advise all students focus on the current grade and what needs to be done to improve.
