Re: Pupil Achievement Tracker

Our primary focus in school is always celebrating those students who demonstrate our school values and meet our high expectations, rewarding them for their efforts.

Next half term we launch a new **Pupil Achievement Tracker** reward scheme. This focuses on rewarding attendance to school, positive behaviour and punctuality. The students can build up their score in each category during the term. Students can achieve a Platinum, Gold, Silver or Bronze standard in recognition of their efforts- with Platinum winners being entered into a Prize draw at the end of the term!

Form tutors have explained this new tracker to the students this week, and they will be sharing the tracker scores weekly in tutor time. Go4Schools will also be updated half termly to show student progress.

We have issued over 2 million positive behaviour points already this year! The Pupil Achievement Tracker will add to our reward system, working alongside existing rewards such as CARE cards, Honours assemblies, Milkshake with the Principal, rewards breakfasts, In it to win it, and rewards trips.
