The test will include questions from the following areas:

- **Physics:** Waves, Electricity, Speed
- **Chemistry:** Atoms, Purity
- **Biology:** Cells, Human Body Systems
- **Scientific Skills:** Drawing and interpreting graphs, analysing data

To help pupils prepare, we recommend the following revision resources:

- **Seneca** – Online homework and revision platform
- **Class Notes** – Pupils should review their own notes and any tasks completed in their Science exercise books.
