All pupils will be sitting Paper 1 in Biology, Chemistry and Physics as part of the mock examination series. The mock examinations are a valuable opportunity for pupils to demonstrate their knowledge and skills under exam conditions. The data gathered from these assessments will help us make informed decisions about whether pupils are best suited to the Higher or Foundation tier papers for their final GCSE examinations. Our aim is always to place pupils on the pathway where they are most likely to succeed and achieve their potential.

In addition, we will be reviewing whether the Triple Science route continues to be the most appropriate option for all pupils. For some, moving to the Combined Science pathway may provide a more suitable balance and a greater opportunity to secure strong grades across the sciences. Where this is the case, we will discuss the decision with you and your child to ensure the best possible outcome.
